

- Discuss the following animal diseases:
- I. Newcastle disease

Solution:

1. ~~It is a~~ Newcastle disease: It is a viral disease that affects mostly poultry animals. It causes neck twisting, green droppings, soft egg shell and somersaulting. It can be contracted by contact with infected droppings and contact with nasal discharges.

2. Foot and Mouth Disease: It is highly communicable. It is a viral disease that affects cattle, sheep, goats, etc. It can be contracted by direct contact with body feed and water. It causes blisters on mouth and udder and

14. Ringworm: It is a fungal disease that affects humans, cattle & birds. It causes skin irritation, weight loss, weakness etc. It can be contracted by contact with infected animals or utensils. It causes skin irritation.

15. Coccidiosis: It affects just poultry and rabbits. It can be ~~contaminated~~ contracted by contaminated feed, water and faeces. It causes diarrhoea, blood stained faeces and ruffled feathers.

16. Trypanosomiasis: It is also called sleeping sickness. It causes tiredness, weakness and often sleep. It is ~~carried~~ carried by tsetse fly. It affects mostly cattle.
