Content of a good First Aid box

- A pair of scissors
- Cotton wool for dressing wound
- lodine for cut
- Bandage

- Plaster
- Triangular bandage
- Safety pin. etc.

Situations/Conditions that require first aid

- 1. Bleeding
- 2. Shock
- 3. Wounds/injuries
- 4. Fracture
- 5. Disclocation
- 6. Asthma attack. etc.

Application of simple First aid

- 1. Apply direct pressure using a clean cloth or sterile dressing directly on the wound.
- 2. Call for assistance immediately
- 3. For nose bleeding adjust the sitting position of the victim, sit the injured person down with the head facing forward.
