It might interest you to know that last primary 6 set (2020/2021 set) made us proud with their Common Entrance Examination Results at both Federal and State levels.

In the Federal Common Entrance Examination, Ogbu Kenenna scored 194 out of 200 marks followed by Okafor Joshua who scored 192. Twelve pupils out of thirty-five that sat for the examination scored 180 and above.

Okafor Joshua as well scored the highest mark in Onitsha zone in the State Common Entrance Examination and were among the overall best pupils in Anambra State.
