Characteristics of a beach: It is a coastal land form, accumulation of sand, gravel or shringle, mostly found where the coast is low lying, could be long covering many kilometers etc.

Formation of a beach: Formed at coastal areas, formed by river deposition, formed by swash and backwash, active where there is low tides, sand and gravel loosened form the land are carried away by waves, may be deposited on the shore as beach, coarse materials are deposited at land ward side, while small and fine particles or materials are deposited at the sea ward end, grows seawards.

 Lake: Lake is a water body accumulated in a depression basin and surrounded by land.

Formation of lake with wind erosion: It occurs mainly in the arid and regions rock deeply weathered, loose none consolidated soil runs deep below surface. No wind breaks, wind speed is high, winds have strong erosive power. Wind deflation sets in a continuous action of wind deflation creates a hollow. Eddy action of the wind further widens and deepens the hollow.
