ACTIVITIES DURING THE TERM

- **i. Resumption: Staff resumption**: The staff resumed on the 28th of April,2025 with prayer, followed by planning meeting and workshop on phonics.
- **ii. Pupils Resumption:** Pupils resumed school on the 5th of May, 2025. Extra lessons began immediately as the term was short.
- iii. Headmistress Test: This was done on 8th of May,2025. This is part of their assessment.
- **iv. May Devotion**: the learners and Staff observed the May devotion in school. Daily recitation of the rosary and reading of Scriptures at the Assembly. We also enlighten the children on the lives of the Saints and the events of the liturgical calendar.
- **v. Phonics**: In order to improve the diction, spelling and reading culture of the learners a phonics instructor was employed to teach the learners. He began with the Staff so that they can apply the same lessons while facilitating their classes.
- vi. African Union Day: Celebrated 23rd May; As part of our academic programme the pupils of OLNNPS are exposed to diverse curriculum for a holistic development and knowledge. As we all know the world is a global village, to mark the African Union day the learners showcased different African culture; dressing, food, language, currency, tourist sites, dance and talked about our African heroes.
- **vii.** Children's Day Celebration: The learners were celebrated in the school, they sang, danced and were happy.
- viii. Sports: The learners have games in school and inter class match.
- **ix. Vocational Programme**: The learners have been engaged in vocational programme to improve on themselves: Baking, barbing, sewing and they are making progress.
- **x. Music**: The pupils both male and female are forming a band. They are learning how to sing, to play the flute and organ and other musical instruments.
- **xi.** Celebrating Virtues: From time to time virtues are talked about at the assembly. The children are encouraged to practice such virtues and learners who display such characters are celebrated at the assembly and given a gift. So far the children have been trying. They submit monies, stationeries misplaced and other articles. Also, they try to keep themselves clean and their environment tidy.
- **xii. Graduation Mass/ Closing Mass of thanksgiving**: We had our maiden graduation Mass of thanksgiving /closing Mass for the session on the 17th of July,2025. This was officiated by Rev.

Fr. Emmanuel Okonedo. He prayed especially for the Basic six learners as they move to the next stage in life and for the Kindergarten three as they step up.

xiii. Workshop for Basic 5 & 6 Learners: They had a workshop to prepare them for the next level. The following were highlighted; time management, discipline, prayer, hard work, peer pressure, bullying, neatness, healthy association and to take care of their belongings among others.

Meetings: Termly, we have planning meetings, mid-term evaluation and end of term meeting and evaluation. We have had the beginning of Term meeting and planning for the staff.

- Mid Term Evaluation: Immediately after resumption from the midterm break, the management and staff evaluate themselves and the terms work. This helped to address recurrent issues, disengage from unproductive activities and agree on the way forward. Issues discussed' amongst others; academic performance, silence hour, orderliness, proper decorum staff/pupil, improvement on teacher parent relationship, attitude to prayer, payment of fees.
